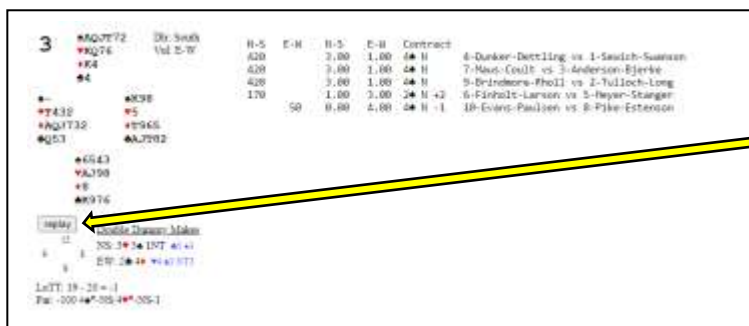


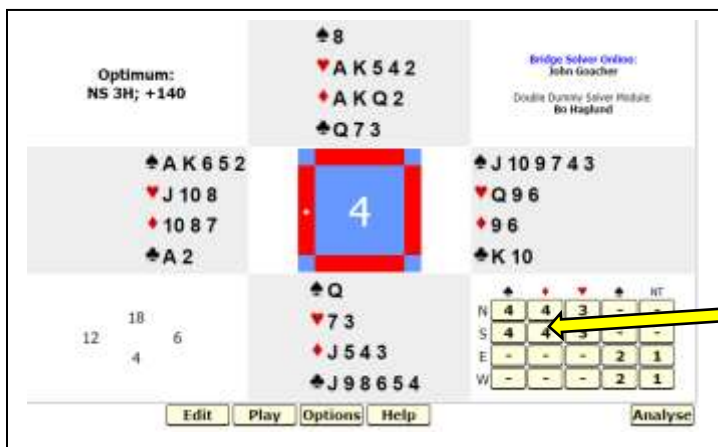
# Using the Bridge Replay feature – [nflbridge.com](http://nflbridge.com)



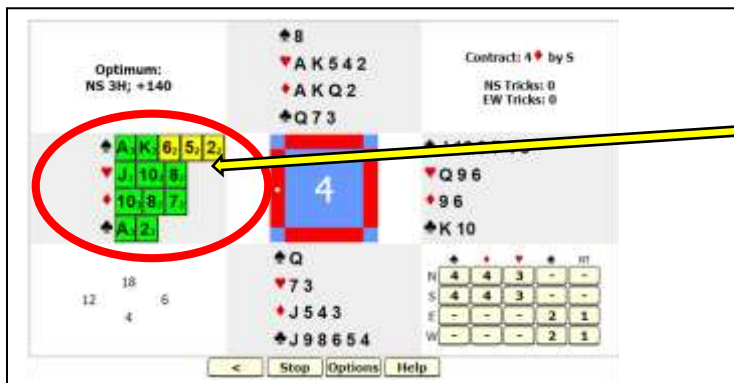
Click on the date for the game



Click on the "replay" button next to the results for the hand you want



Click on the suit and declarer you want; here South playing in  $\heartsuit$   
 Note that the 4 in the box indicates highest contract that south can make in this suit



The hand that is on lead lights up  
 To play a card, click on it, and the screen will move to the next hand

The subscript shows the maximum number of tricks this side can take if they lead this card

Green boxes are the best leads  
 Yellow boxes are not so good  
 On this hand, only a low spade is a bad lead
